In Fiscal Year 2022 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022) Northern Illinois Food Bank – through our network of more than 900 food pantries, soup kitchens and feeding programs – provided 78 million meals across our 13-county service area. Here is a snapshot of our partnerships and work in Ogle County:

- 10 Child Program Sites

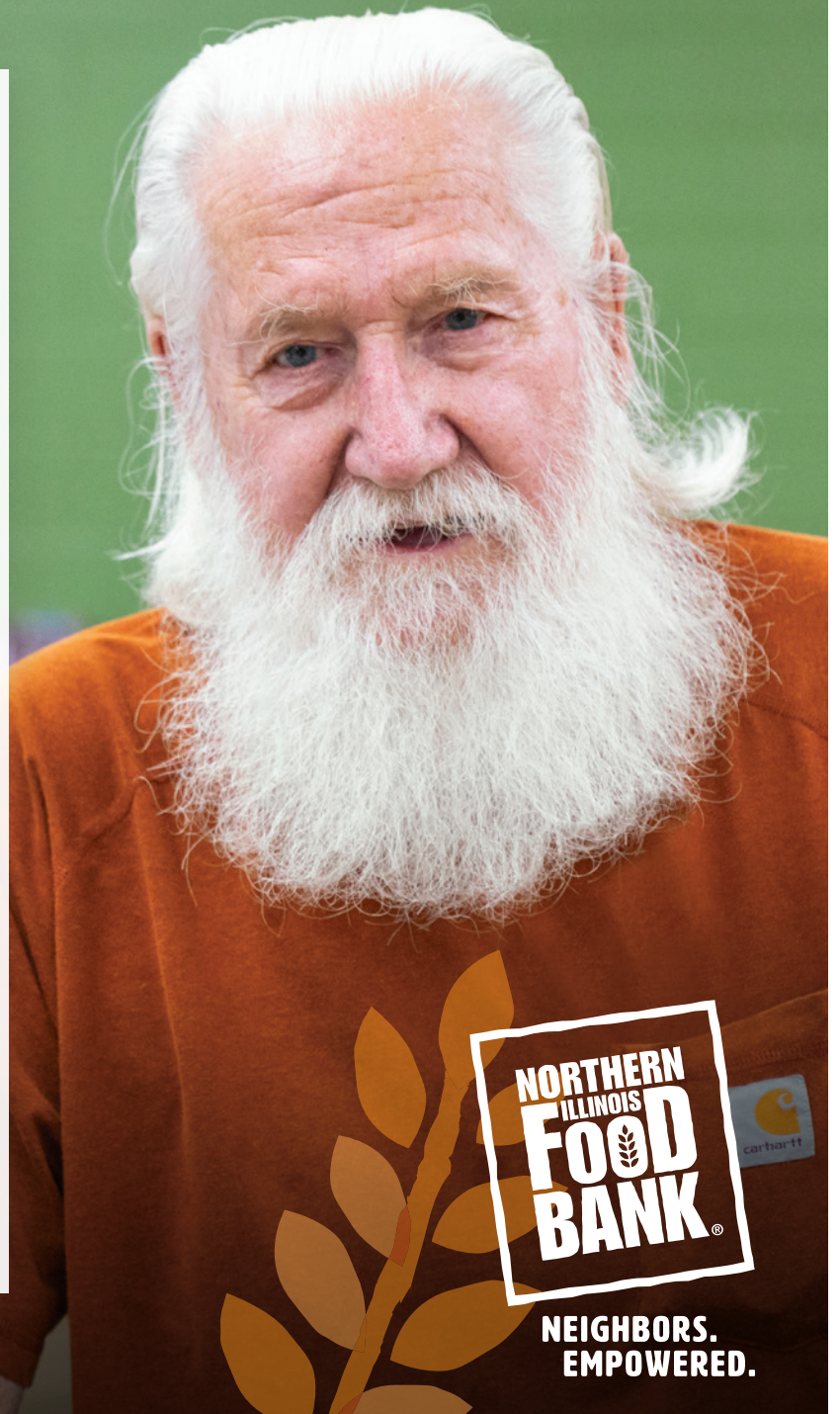
